MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

This title is in the Labor Class and there are no minimum education or experience requirements for the title.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS

Employees in this title work in the Community Pride Program and assist with the performance of unskilled tasks aimed at improving the quality of life of Town residents by maintaining, repairing, and renovating community open spaces, buildings and facilities. Work is performed under direct supervision of a Labor Crew Leader or a maintenance employee depending on assignment. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES

Assists with the performance of a variety of grounds maintenance activities, such as mowing and trimming lawn edges, gathering leaves, planting new trees and shrubs;

Clears streams, beaches, lakes and ponds of debris;

Sweeps and removes litter from town facilities, roadways, and vacant lots;

Assists with simple painting;

Assists higher-level employees with simple maintenance tasks throughout the Town.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES and PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS

Ability to understand and follow simple oral instructions; ability to use basic tools; ability to learn to operate simple machinery; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
