

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code, will be held by the Town of Babylon L. D. Corporation II (the "Corporation") on the 18th day of November, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. local time, in the office of the John Braslow, Esq., 816 Deer Park Avenue, North Babylon, New York 11703, for the purpose of giving interested persons an opportunity to be heard with respect to the following matters:

Dominican Village, Inc. (the "Institution"), which is an organization formed as not for profit corporation under New York Law for the purpose of providing elderly housing and exempt from federal income taxation pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, has requested that the Corporation issue its tax-exempt revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$18,500,000 and its taxable revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$450,000 (collectively, the "Bonds") for the purposes of (i) refunding the portion of the outstanding principal amount of the New York State Housing Finance Agency Multi-Family Revenue Bonds (Secured Mortgage Program), Series B Refunding allocable to financing and refinancing a senior housing complex consisting of 6 buildings aggregating 328,000 square feet (the "Facilities"), (ii) refunding a loan made by the New York State Housing Finance Agency for the purpose of funding a portion of the cost of renovating, expanding and equipping an existing building for use as an event hall and conference center, which is part of the Facilities, (iii) funding a debt service reserve fund for the

Bonds and (iv) paying the costs of issuance of the Bonds. The Facilities, all of which are complete and in operation, consist of 266 residential units (200 independent living units and 66 assisted living units), together with related support facilities (including common areas for socialization, café and convenience shop, dining area, lounge/bar, laundry room, game room, library, medical suite, hair salon, event hall and conference center, gardens and patios, and off-street parking). The Facilities are owned and operated by the Institution for the purpose of providing a mixture of low income and affordable housing for elderly persons. The Facilities are located at 565 Albany Avenue in Amityville, New York 11701.

In connection with the issuance of the Bonds, the Corporation will loan the proceeds of the Bonds to the Institution, which shall use the Bond proceeds for the above-described purposes. The Corporation contemplates that it will provide financial assistance in the form of such tax-exempt bond and taxable bond financing and exemption from mortgage recording taxes in accordance with the policies of the Corporation. The Bonds will be special obligations of the Corporation payable solely from certain amounts payable under an agreement with the Institution pledged to the repayment of the Bonds and secured by a mortgage on the Facilities.

A representative of the Corporation will at the above-stated time and place hear and accept written comments from all persons with views in favor of or opposed to either the proposed financial assistance to the Corporation or the location or nature of the Facilities.
